A Public Meeting of the Berkeley Township Municipal Utilities Authority was held on Thursday, <u>January 28, 2021</u> at 7:00 pm at the Berkeley Township Municipal Utilities Authority at 42 Station Road, Bayville, NJ 08721. Presided by Chairman Hale-present, Jerome Bollettieri-present, Edward Cammarato-present, Samuel Cammarato-present, Richard Elliott-absent, Lawrence Borio-absent, William McGrath-absent.

Also present: John Sahradnik-Attorney, Keith Chiaravallo-Engineer, Brian Waldron-Accountant, and Michele Nugent-Executive Director.

After the salute to the flag, Ms. Del Conte read the Open Public Meeting Statement.

Mr. Hale stated on behalf of the Board he wishes Commissioner Borio a speedy recovery. Mrs. Nugent stated it will be noted Commissioner Borio is on a medical leave.

Motion to approve the Public Meeting Minutes, Executive Session Minutes and the following reports from the meeting on December 17, 2020: Jerome Bollettieri, second, Samuel Cammarato. The motion was approved by voice vote. There were no "nay" votes. Motion Carried.

## Treasurer's Report:

Mr. Samuel Cammarato stated for the six week period (12/19/20-01/29/21) the payroll expenses totaled \$69,403.56 and the operational expenses totaled \$161,345.68. The operational expenses include one payment to Montana Construction for \$46,675.32 which will be separately authorized by resolution at tonight's meeting.

Edward Cammarato and Samuel Cammarato reviewed the six weeks.

Motion to approve the Treasurer's Report: Jerome Bollettieri, second, Richard Elliott. The motion was approved by voice vote. There were no "nay" votes. Motion Carried.

## **Executive Director's Report:**

Accept & close out Well# 4 project/Authorize final payment & release of retainage total \$46,675.32 to Montana Construction:

Mrs. Nugent stated authorization for this resolution will be deferred until after Mr. Chiaravallo makes his presentation regarding the close-out of the Well# 4 project.

Mrs. Nugent referred to the Progress Report and presented the highlights:

- COVID Statues No employee illness related to the COVID concerns. The State vaccination program lists utility workers as 1B status for scheduling COVID vaccine appointments.
- Meeting Dates Re-organization public meeting is scheduled for February 25, 2021.
- NJUAJIF/MEL Credit The Elected Official Training Seminar is accessible online. The Authority receives a \$250.00 credit towards the Authority's insurance premium for each Commissioner's participation. The classes are available until May 1, 2021. Mr. Hale questioned if it would be permissible for the Commissioners to participate in the online classes at the Authority. Mrs. Nugent stated an accommodation can be set up.

Mr. Edward Cammarato questioned if an Authority employee could be compelled to receive the COVID vaccine as a condition of employment. Mrs. Nugent replied the Authority received guidance that it is not recommended to mandate an employee to receive the vaccine.

## **Engineer's Report:**

#### Phase VII Water System Improvements:

Mr. Chiaravallo stated CME continues with the planning and preparation design of Phase VII water mains.

## Annual Engineer's Report:

Mr. Chiaravallo stated the Annual Engineering's Report is a summary of work that occurred during 2020 and provides a brief description of the Plant operations. Mr. Chiaravallo reviewed the key points of the report.

## Well# 4 Project:

Mr. Chiaravallo stated the contractor has completed all of the work on Well# 4. The enhancements and improvements to the system have provided more resiliency for backups and alarms. Well# 4 is in normal rotation. Mr. Chiaravallo stated the final payment submitted is \$46,675.32. The contract is under the original contract amount by slightly over \$31,000.00. Mr. Hale questioned if this amount included the enhancements. Mr. Chiaravallo replied yes. Mr. Chiaravallo added, the two year maintenance bond will be in place and cover any possible issues. Mr. Edward Cammarato directed the Auditor to review this bill when performing the audit.
