RESOLUTION OF THE BERKELEY TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, REGARDING WELL #4, PHASE II

WHEREAS, Montana Construction Corp., Inc., was the winning bidder on the Well #4, Phase II project for the Berkeley Township Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter referred to as the "Authority"); and

WHEREAS, there was a Notice to Proceed, dated December 1, 2017, and the contractor initiated the project; and

WHEREAS, a voucher titled Pay Estimate #3 was presented to the Authority and CME Associates for work that was completed between July 14, 2018 through August 10, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the total construction costs associated with the voucher that was submitted was \$217,230.82; and

WHEREAS, the Authority pursuant to Agreement is to deduct a 2% retainage or a total of \$4,344.61; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's Engineer has reviewed the voucher and supporting documentation and has approved payment to Montana Construction Corp., Inc.;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, this 23rd day of August, 2018, by the Berkeley Township Municipal Utilities Authority, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. The Authority accepts the recommendation of its Engineer, CME Associates, with regard to their review of an invoice that was provided for work done on the above-referenced project from July 14, 2018 through August 10, 2018.
- 2. The Authority authorizes the payment to Montana Construction Corp., Inc., of \$212,886.21 which represents the net amount due from the original invoice of \$217,230.82 less a retainage of \$4,344.61.

3. The Authority hereby authorizes and directs the Chairperson, Secretary, Executive Director and Authority Attorney to execute any and all necessary documents in order to implement the intent of this Resolution.
