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RESOLUTION OF THE BERKELEY TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY, TOWNSHIP OF BERKELEY, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NJ GRANTING A REDUCTION IN PERFORMANCE BOND REQUIREMENT TO BERKELEY TERRACE, BLOCK 1014, LOT 26.01

WHEREAS, the Berkeley Township Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter referred to as the "Authority") granted an application for preliminary, tentative and final water approval for the property set forth above as designated on the official tax map of the Township of Berkeley by Resolution 2022-37; and

WHEREAS, the Authority modified that approval in Resolution 2023-47 to accept the project to proceed in separate phases; and

WHEREAS, Berkeley Terrace had previously posted with the Authority a performance bond consisting of \$506,332.90 in surety bond and a cash amount of \$39,817.33; and

WHEREAS, Berkeley Terrace has requested a reduction in the amount of performance guarantees due to the status of the project; and

WHEREAS, the Authority Engineer, Keith Chiaravallo, P.E., of CME Associates, has reviewed the status of the project and has provided a recommendation to reduce the performance guarantees in compliance with the Rules and Regulations of the Authority in a report, dated November 6, 2023, due to the fact that a substantial amount of the infrastructure has been completed; and

WHEREAS, the developer has completed all of Phase I as described in the CME report, dated November 6, 2023, making it eligible for performance bond reduction; and

WHEREAS, the same CME report calculates the bond requirements for the area described as Phase II still required and planned; and

WHEREAS, the developer has provided written notice to the removal of a portion of the project, specifically Phase III Pelham Avenue loop as described in the same CME report, making it eligible for performance bond reduction; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED this 9th day of November, 2023, by the Berkeley Township Municipal Utilities Authority as follows:

1. The Authority accepts the recommendation of its Consulting Engineering for the reduction in performance guarantees to the following levels:

WHEREAS, Authority Resolution 2022-0034 established terms of employment and compensation for Brian Blair for the period of May 2022 through May 19, 2025; and
