# RESOLUTION OF THE BERKELEY TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY, TOWNSHIP OF BERKELEY, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NJ GRANTING AN ADDITIONAL REDUCTION IN PERFORMANCE BOND REQUIREMENT TO BERKELEY TERRACE, BLOCK 1014, LOT 26.01

WHEREAS, the Berkeley Township Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter referred to as the "Authority") granted an application for preliminary, tentative and final water approval for the property set forth above as designated on the official tax map of the Township of Berkeley by Resolution 2022-37; and

WHEREAS, the Authority modified that approval in Resolution 2023-47 to accept the project to proceed in separate phases; and

WHEREAS, BTMUA Resolution 2023-47 also accepted a performance bond consisting of \$506,332.90 in surety bond and a cash amount of \$39,817.33: and

WHEREAS, BTMUA Resolution 2023-61 reduced the bond requirement to \$282.229.93 consisting of \$254.906.63 surety and \$28,323.00 cash; and

WHEREAS. Berkeley Terrace has requested an additional reduction in the amount of performance guarantees due to the status of the project; and

WHEREAS, the Authority Engineer, Keith Chiaravallo, P.E., of CME Associates, has reviewed the status of the project and has provided a recommendation to further reduce the performance guarantees in compliance with the Rules and Regulations of the Authority in a report, dated September 17, 2024, due to the fact that a substantial amount of the infrastructure has been completed; and

WHEREAS, the developer has completed all of Phase I. II and III as described in the CME report, dated September 17, 2024, making it eligible for performance bond reduction; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** this 26<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2024, by the Berkeley Township Municipal Utilities Authority as follows:

1. The Authority accepts the recommendation of its Consulting Engineering for the reduction in performance guarantees to the following levels:

	Original	Revised Amount
90% Bond Portion	\$506,332.90 To	\$151,896.87
10% Cash Portion	\$39,817.33 To	\$16,877.44
Total Performance Guarantee	\$546,150.23	\$168,774.31

- 2. This approval is contingent upon Berkeley Terrace's submission of an affidavit to the Authority certifying that all contractors and suppliers in connection with the project have been paid in full as of the date of this resolution.
- 3. The Authority hereby authorizes and directs the Chairperson, Secretary and Executive Director to execute any and all necessary documents in order to implement the intent of this Resolution.
